2010 Scholarship Application



Application Deadline: May 3, 2010

Open to any graduating high school senior (or equivalent) living within the boundaries of the Kingman Unified School District and planning to continue his or her formal education.

The Kingman Mohave Lions Club is pleased to provide scholarship funds for 2010 graduating seniors. Our Lions wish to support youth and make aware the importance of giving time and talent in community service. We encourage school faculty to make all qualifying seniors aware of the *Kingman Mohave Lions Club Scholarship* and assist community service minded and well rounded students in submitting a qualified application.

Amount of Scholarship Funds

\$500 per awardee, up to \$750 for an awardee attending an accredited school of higher learning located within the Kingman area. *These funds are not designed to cover living expenses, but rather to help the student cover books, tuition and class fees at a local accredited college or trade school.*

Eligibility Criteria

Scholarship funds are being made available to 2010 high school graduates (or equivalent) who have lived within the boundaries of the Kingman Unified School District for at least the last year and are planning on furthering their formal education.

Selection Criteria

Scholarship applications must be typed or neatly hand written addressing **all** of the following criteria. Each application must be accompanied by the applicant's current transcript. Incomplete applications will not be considered. The attachment of additional sheets of paper is acceptable as long as each answer references which question it addresses. The areas of emphasis by which applications will be judged are as follows:

- * 1/3 – Community service, involvement and work history
- * 1/3 – Written essays (*neat, organized and well thought out demonstrating ambitious but realistic goals*)
- * 1/3 – Financial Need (*expressed through the essays*)

Final Selection

To keep the judging process as fair as possible, identification will be removed from the copies of applications submitted to the panel of judges. Scholarship recipients will be chosen based on the selection criteria listed above. Announcements will be made at each recipient's respective Senior Awards Ceremony, awardees not in attendance will receive his or her letter of acceptance in the mail. Once final selections have been announced, ***funds will be made available to the college of the awardee upon enrollment, not to the student.***

Submission

Completed applications may be turned in to your school guidance counselor or to the District Administration of KUSD or KAOL. Completed applications may also be mailed to the following address:

Application Submission Deadline

April 30, 2010: Completed applications must be turned in to a school guidance counselor or District Administrator no later than 12:00 PM on April 30, 2010 for transmission to the Lions Club Scholarship Chairperson.

May 3, 2010: Completed applications sent by mail must be received by the Lions Club Scholarship Chairperson no later than May 3, 2010.

A current transcript is required. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
